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" TO ORGANIZE SELF-AWARENESS AMONG THE CREATOR CLASS"

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One of the prime objectives of the Society of Free Space Colonizers should be to organize self-awareness among the Creator Class on this planet. The Creator Class does not, at this time, know itself. There are a great number of individuals who have a partial consciousness of their superiority as self-standing entities. However, the present altruist-collectivist environment is often able to redirect, hinder and often destroy these creator elements of the individual.

The independent, self-motivated, self-centered, ethically-coherent individual is despised in every culture on this planet. For instance, the talented individual is gently cajoled into the little white lies of modesty and humility. And if the individual has the integrity to resist being made into a pious clown of altruist etiquette, he is then not so gently coerced through ostracism.

Altruist-collectivist ostracism is an attempt to reduce the opportunities for rewarding relationships with other persons. More fundamentally the individual is made to feel shame and self-denigration for rationally seeking an improvement of its economic status, sexual gratification and egoistical forms of expression in dress, speech and housing.

An even more insidious form of usurping the creative individual employs "the carrot and the stick" method of flattery and 'argument by intimidation': (1) the creative individual, denied the healthy and rational self-expression of his capacities by the altruist-collectivist injunction of modesty and humility, is reduced to accepting whatever morsels are thrown its way by the manipulative socio-paths so widely present in the altruist-collectivist society.

Should the creative individual choose to question the tenets of this irrational system, it is made to feel inferior by implication for even having asked the question. For instance, the individual's straightforward question is met with sighs of impatience and incredulous sarcasm with the end-result often being that the individual feels embarrassed for having displayed "ignorance". The individual never gets an answer. The individual is merely coerced, flattered, cajoled and intimidated into accepting implied values second-hand.

This is the way, state-operated, liberal-controlled universities and colleges are run today. There is a very clever and thoroughgoing process of intimidation operating

on campus today. One which you are forced to support with tax dollars.

Of course, there are other arms of the altruist-collectivist complex which operate to intimidate and disintegrate the self-belief of the individual. Among these, are liberal elements of the press, public television, naturalism (2) in literature, drama and films. There are also, the so called student radical and minority movements which can mobilize a tremendous pressure on the individual.

The individual is continuously bombarded with an abased view of individual humans. Films such as Andy Warhole's "Trash" are a good example of the current genre of so-called "socially advanced" films supposedly portraying 'life in the raw'. These films are not "life" but scenarios for death. The altruist-collectivist 'intelligentsia' emulate these heroes of self destruction whether they be Holly Woodlawn, Bonny and Clyde or Shaft. The mass cult films only alternative to personal ethical suicide is the weeping, self-pity of 'Love Story'. In spite of itself, 'Love Story' does provide a profound message about altruist-collectivist society for it personifies the motivating principle of the individual's life in that context, i.e. that of weakly and self-pitiably waiting for death.

In 'Love Story' one denotes a peculiar lack of consciously understood values and of long term objectives and overriding life goals in these graduates of Harvard and Radcliffe. This is the model which the altruist-collectivist establishment implies as the only acceptable alternative to the shrill, psychopathic, model of Warhole's "trash". By default of a better model to emulate, many individuals take on traits from these popular heroes. The only way to becoming an individualist according to these rules is to be a predatory renegade or a vacantly insipid, masochistic fool.

As a result of these conditions of living within an altruist-collectivist society many if not most of the potential members of the Creator Class are being abused and destroyed. We of the Society of Free Space Colonizers have both a duty to ourselves and an opportunity to provide a service to beleaguered individualists all over this planet.

These services should not be given away but traded for money and/ or time and effort. I.e. the SFSC should not start-off on the wrong foot by encouraging the altruist something-for nothing syndrome.

I would propose the following framework for any program for organizing self-awareness among the Creator Class by the SFSC. First, not all members of the SFSC are

consciously part of the Creator Class. As a result, they often make mistakes in representing to others the meaning and function of the SFSC. Members of the SFSC who are truly interested in organizing the Creator Class and creating its mission in space, would do well to instruct themselves on Creator Class ethics, metaphysics, epistemology and esthetics.

Second, concrete and practical mediums designated as organs for informing the Creator Class should be of a profit making nature. For instance, I propose that admission be charged to our meetings from hereon in which not only covers the costs of the meeting but provides a wage for the speakers and organizers.
